UNDERWATER OBSERVATORY



Descend 64 steps (10 metres) underwater into a large viewing area where windows open your eyes to this underwater haven. Unlike an aquarium, the fish are free to come and go; it's the people who are contained. Stay a little longer and you won't just see Milford Sound, you'll experience it!





Milford Sound GETTING THERE

If Milford Sound is the eighth wonder of the world, the road to Milford is surely the ninth. The best way to experience both is by travelling on a Southern Discoveries coach and cruise day trip from Queenstown or Te Anau.

Road to Milford Sound highlights:



Mirror Lakes

Small tarns (mountain lakes) on the roadside provide outstanding reflections in calm weather. A 10 minute walk with views of the Earl Mountains.



Eglington Valley

A beautiful glaciated valley with steep sides and a flat floor. It's up to 2 kilometres (1.2 miles) wide and has a shingle riverbed which is constantly being changed by the Eglington River.



Homer Tunnel

At an altitude of 945 metres (3100 feet) above sea level and 1.2 kilometres (0.75 miles) in length, the road tunnel allows access through sheer rock to Milford Sound with a gradient of 1 in 10.



Monkey Creek

Located in the Hollyford Valley, Monkey Creek is a glacial fed spring with water so pure you can drink straight from it. It's the perfect place to fill up your water bottle. You are likely to spot some friendly Kea here too.




INDIAN BUFFET

Southern Discoveries is passionate about preserving Milford Sound's wildlife for future generations. We are a proud supporter of the Tawaki Project, a long term study of the marine ecology, breeding biology and population dynamics of the world's least known, most enigmatic penguin species, New Zealand's crested penguins – Tawaki.



Our sustainable business practices include:

A mammal viewing permit issued by the Department of Conservation to ensure the protection of all mammal life in Milford Sound

New Zealand coastal permits are issued for all our vessels. This ensures safe operating practices; that all vessels operate below certain noise levels, no discharge is allowed into the fiord and all emissions are closely monitored.

Japanese Obento and Thali Indian Lunches are prepared in reusable packs. Anti-waste packaging purchasing decisions are mandatory in our business
